09.00hrs: After breakfast we depart by coach for our visit to RHS Garden Wisley. Wisley is the flagship garden of the RHS and one of the UK's most visited and best-loved gardens. After a special formal welcome and talk about the award winning gardens you can join one of the Wisley experts for a guided tour and discover what makes Wisley such an amazing garden to visit. This is followed by an RHS hosted lunch and free time to explore the garden at leisure.

14.00rs: Our coach departs for the Denbies Wine Estate where the Denbies team will be looking forward to welcoming you. Our visit starts with a sparkling vineyard train tour and a glass of Denbies Sparkling Whitedowns Cuvee.

This is followed by a classic wine tasting experience which starts with a Vineyards through the Seasons film before we go through the atmospheric cellars for a guided tasting of Denbies classic wine.
