


Great Group Options

Guided tours

- Our guided tours are the perfect way to discover the Cathedral's amazing history, spaces, and secrets.
- Our tours are delivered by our own Cathedral guides who have a wealth of stories to tell you.
- Each guided tour is £5 per person and lasts approximately 75 minutes.
- Pre-booked group tours can be arranged Monday-Saturday, from 10:00-15:00. Although there is no maximum group size, we try to keep a maximum of 15 people to each guide.





Types of Tour

- Our 'Inside Story' tour offers a great introduction to our history and architecture
- The 'Stained Glass' at the Cathedral tour covers 1,000 years of stained glass
- The 'Thomas Becket Story' tells tales of martyrs, monarchs and miracles
- 'Crown and Cathedral' focuses on royal links at Canterbury Cathedral
- 'Christmas at the Cathedral' uncovers festive imagery in stained glass and tells stories of Christmas traditions through the ages.

Special Tours

- Our Evening Guided tour is an exclusive out-of-hours tour with the Cathedral all to yourselves
- The 'UNESCO Sites tour' is a full day tour with guided tours at all three UNESCO sites in Canterbury, with an included lunch.
- 'Climb the Corona Tower' tour takes you up 95 steps to discover wonderful views of the city



Get Behind the Scenes

- Our Stonemasons' Yard tours tell you how the Cathedral was built and how it is maintained today, told by our stonemasons themselves!
- Discover the Archives and historic Library on a specialist tour led by one of the Archives and Library team who can bring hundreds of years of collecting to life.

Enjoy 'entrance only' visits and make your own way around at your own pace.


Groups enjoying entrance only tickets will receive a map and basic guide leaflet.
